- Find a Leaf of Every Color Red, yellow, green, brown—how many colors can you spot?
- Listen to the Sounds of Nature Can you hear birds, wind, insects, or rustling leaves?
- Touch and Describe Find something rough, smooth, soft, or bumpy. Describe it together!
- Search for Shapes in the Clouds What animals or objects can your child imagine in the sky?
- Look Under a Rock or Log Carefully lift it—what tiny creatures live underneath?
- Smell Something Natural A flower, a pinecone, or fresh-cut grass—what does nature smell like today?
- Collect Nature Treasures Gather leaves, pebbles, feathers, or twigs for a treasure bag.
- Tell a Story About Something You See Make up a magical tale about a tree, a bug, or a hidden fairy path.
- Play 'I Spy' with Nature 'I spy with my little eye... something that grows!' Who finds it first?
- Close Your Eyes and Feel the Air Is it warm, cool, breezy? What does it feel like to just be still?
